# HOW TO ENTER

Anyone can enter the competitions in the marquee (other than classes 49-55, & 117-119, which are restricted to those living 6 miles or less from Burnham Market).

You can enter as many different classes as you like, and can make 2 entries in the same class if you wish. The entry forms on page 21 can be copied or downloaded from our website [www.burnhamsflowershow.co.uk](http://www.burnhamsflowershow.co.uk).

There is a fee of 20p per entry. Please complete the form, making sure to enclose your phone number if you are entering classes 49-55, or 117-119. Please hand your form, with the entry fee of 20p per class, to Burnham Market Stores, Burnham Market Garage or Burnham Market Post Office or by post to the Show Secretary, Diana Black, 6, The Fighthe, Burnham Thorpe, PE31 8HT.

Please make your entries by 1pm on Friday 10th July. Making them in advance makes our lives much easier, so please do this if you can. It will be possible to make entries on the day, but at an increased cost of 40p (20p for children). PLEASE enter your photos in advance, as they are time consuming to display, and will not be accepted after 9am on the day.

## ON THE DAY

On the day of the show, please bring your entries to the Marquee between 8am and 10am. Your show entry cards with your exhibitor number and class numbers will be ready for you to collect from the committee table. You then place your entries in the appropriate area of the Marquee, ready for judging. There will be Flower Show Helpers to assist if you're not sure what goes where etc. It will be possible to make entries on the day, but at an increased cost of 40p (20p for children).

**Photography entries will not be accepted after 9am, as explained above.**

## REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS AND AUCTION

Entries need to stay in place until 4.30, so they can be seen and enjoyed by as many people as possible. At 4.30, they can be removed, or left in place and donated to the Auction, which will take place at approximately 5pm in the Marquee.

# PARKIN RECIPE

Ingredients 225g golden syrup, 50g black treacle, 110g butter, 110g soft dark brown sugar, 225g medium oatmeal, 110g self raising flour, 2 teaspoons ground ginger, pinch salt, 1 large egg, beaten, 1 tablespoon milk.

Method Combine golden syrup, treacle, butter and sugar in a saucepan, place over gentle heat until butter melted. Measure flour, oatmeal, ginger & salt into mixing bowl, then add warmed ingredients & mix until combined. Then add beaten egg, then milk. Pour into lined 2lb loaf tin, and bake on middle shelf in low oven (140degrees) for 1 ½ hours. Cool in tin for 30minutes before turning out onto rack.

Hint-Parkin is best made in advance, as it improves over several days-if it lasts that long!
